
Dear Mr. Kugler,

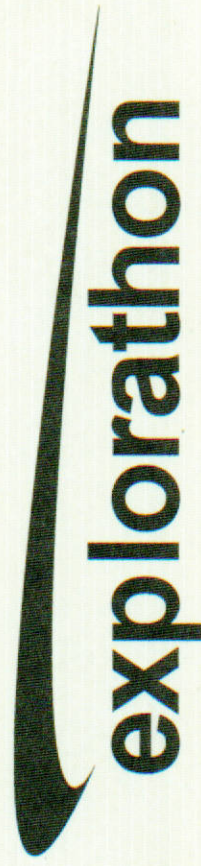
